iv. Officials	Chief- <i>eranistes</i> (ἀρχεραμιστής, <i>archeranistes</i>), ll. 5-6 Secretary (γραμματεὺς, <i>grammateus</i>), l. 5 Accountant (λογιστής, <i>logistes</i>) l. 6 Stewards (ἐπιμεληταί, <i>epimeletai</i>) l. 7. They are designated as 3 συνεπιμεληταί, <i>synepimeletai</i> .

Note	There are five individuals - office holders, all men: Μάκρων, Λεύκων, Δωρόθεος, Μοσχίων, Διονυσόδωρος.

iii. Worship	The editor assumes that the group worshipped Artemis <i>Ariste</i> and <i>Kalliste</i> .
Deities worshipped	Artemis (?)
iv. Honours/Other activities	The association crowned (ἐστεφάνωσεν, <i>estephanosen</i> , ll. 3-4) their officials.

XII. NOTES

i. Comments	It is possible that the present group is related to that in IG II ² 1297 (CAPInv. 268) and IG II ² 1298 (CAPInv. 269). In view of this, I am not sure whether we should interpret literally the phrase <i>hous synelexen</i> (l. 3), as referring to the group's foundation.
