	Note	The only woman is the <i>mater Romanorum</i> .

Status	The <i>origo</i> is mentioned for all members: $n(atus)$ - Two persons are from Nicomedia, two from <i>Abonutichus</i> (i.e. <i>Abonou teichos</i>), one from Heracleia (Pontica), one from Perinthus, one from (an unknown) Caesarea, two from Tius (besides the <i>mater Romanorum</i>), one from Mazaca and one of unknown origin (because the stone is broken).

iii. Worship	Given the dedication to <i>(H)eros et D[ominus?]</i> (i.e. the Thracian Rider), worship by the group can be supposed. However, this was surely not the main divinity of the association.

i.	Comments	The presence of a woman at the head of the members might suggest an association of Roman worshippers of Cybele.
