i. Comments

There were several *synodoi* at Smyrna; it is unclear whether or not this fragment should be associated with one of them. L. 4 mentions a συνέδριον, *synedrion* (possibly the γέροντες, *gerontes*; cf. Petzl ad loc.), ll. 6-7 could be restored τοῖς μετέχου[σι τοῦ γυμνασίου], *tois metechou[si tou gymnasiou]* (cf. Petzl ad loc.).
