i.b.	Document(s) typology & language/script	The first document is an honorific decree; the second document is a funerary inscription. If someone acts against the will of the tomb's owner by burying someone else there or selling the place, he shall pay a fine to the <i>erioplytai</i> . Greek.
i.c.	Physical format(s)	The first document is a white marble plate.
ii.	Source(s) provenance	The first document was found near the theatre of Hierapolis.

iv. Endowments	The association is the recipient of a funerary endowment ( <i>stephanotikon</i> ; in Pennacchietti's edition ( <i>AAT</i> 101: 317, no. 45), it is qualified as "great", <i>mega</i> , but the Roberts have plausibly argued for a different reading). The coronation of the grave shall take place on the birthday ( <i>genethlion</i> , <i>AAT</i> 101: 317, no. 45, 1. 8) of the deceased woman's son.

ii. Meetings and events	The association was entrusted with taking care of a grave.
iv. Honours/Other activities	Altertümer von Hierapolis 40 is an honorific decree for a man who had served as <i>strategos</i> , <i>agonothetes</i> , <i>grammateus</i> (Altertümer von Hierapolis 40, ll. 6-7) of the temples of Asia, <i>presbeutes</i> and <i>archiereus</i> (Altertümer von Hierapolis 40, ll. 12-14; he is described as a "benefacter of the homeland".

i. Local interaction	The association honors the same person as do the <i>porphyrabaphoi</i> (Altertümer von Hierapolis 41); both associations use the same wording.
