i.b.	Document(s) typology & language/script	The Demotic inscription is a dedication, made by the <i>mr šn</i> of an association of Hathor, and by all the association.
i.c.	Physical format(s)	Sandstone stela (35 x 26 cm) showing a king making an offering to three deities.
ii.	Source(s) provenance	Both editors agree that the stela comes from Dendera, from the contents.

ii.	Leadership	The <i>mr šn</i> (<i>lesonis</i>) cited 1. 2-3 is probably the president of the association. The <i>lesonis</i> is usually an official attached to temples. In an association, the <i>mr šn</i> is an administrator or the president (De Cenival 1972: 154-159). Considering the way the title is mentioned in the inscription, it appears slightly more likely that it refers here to the function in the association.
iii.	Members	Referred to as $n \square m \square w(n) \square$ ('the people (from the) association', 1. 3).
v.	Other staff	At the end of the text, another hand added the name of a man named Apollonios, a herdsman of the prophet of the god Re (the reading of the name of the god is unsure). We do not know if this person is attached to the association.

	Note	The one person named is male. We do not know about the others.
