XIII. EVALUATION

i. Private association	Probable
Note	There is no indication of activity by an association, only the dedication by the <i>prostatas</i> (perhaps of an association) of a statues of Herakles and Harpocrates. Associations of Harpocrates are attested, however; see P.Mich. V 246, a group in Tebtynis (CAPInv. 1276).
