He is 'First of the city', (<i>protos tes poleos</i>), because of his ambition of glory and his benevolence towards his fatherland.</p> <p>On the importance of honorific inscriptions set up by private associations in order to commemorate the relationships that they maintained with the leading members of society cf. Nijf 1997: 73</p>
