ix. Privileges	The association paid for the funerary monument of one its members, along with the deceased's father.

iv. Status	The deceased was a μουλίων, <i>moulion</i> (l. 4), mule-driver; this was therefore most probably a professional association of transport workers; such an association is also attested at Beroia (see <a href="#">CAPInv. 479</a> ).
