Despite the fragmentary state of preservation, the text seems to constitute a decree/ list of regulations passed probably by civic authorities, something that can be further corroborated by the findspot of the inscription, i.e. in the prytaneion. The term <i>thiasotika</i> is juxtaposed to the term <i>choritika</i> (1. 5: $\mathring{\eta}$ θιασωτικά $\mathring{\eta}$ χωριτικά). It may refer to plots of land (χωρία?) of private associations.
