<b>ii. Leadership</b>	$\alpha'$ κναφάριος = πρωτοκναφάριος, <i>I knapharios</i> = <i>protoknapharios</i> , has been suggested as the title of the leader of an association, see XII.i: Comments.
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## XII. NOTES

<b>i. Comments</b>	<p>Dölger 1932: 394 suggested to read <math>\alpha'</math> κναφάριος, <i>I knapharios</i>, instead of ἀκναφάριος, <i>aknapharios</i>, and interpreted it as a short form for πρωτοκναφάριος, <i>protoknapharios</i>. He thought the term is used analogous to πρωταυράριος, <i>protaurarios</i>, maybe the leader of the association of the goldsmiths in Corycus (cf. the comments to <a href="#">CAPInv. 1018</a>). Robert (1969: 916) refused this reading: “Cela ferait bien des ‘présidents des γναφάριοι’ et alors que l’on ne connaît pas de γναφάριοι; il n’y a pas de signe sur l’alpha ou après, indiquant que c’est un chiffre; nulle part dans cette série d’inscriptions le πρώτος formant la première partie du mot (πρωταυράριος) n’est indiqué par un chiffre (<math>\alpha'</math> αὐράριος).”</p> <p>For ἀκναφάριος/ἀγναφάριος, <i>aknapharios/agnapharios</i>, cf.
