The group has agreed to execute the construction of a part of the theater (Il. 2-3: ἐργολάβοι τοῦ μέρους τοῦ θεάτρου, *ergolaboi tou merous tou theatrou*). When both technical problems with the construction and difficulties with their employment arose, the builders asked the oracle at Didyma for advice (the nature of the difficulties is disputed; cf. with further literature Dittmann-Schöne 2002: 72-3; Oesterheld 2008: 438-9 n. 277). The oracle recommends to continue the work and to ask an experienced architect for help. Furthermore, the group should sacrifice to Athena and Heracles.

	However, Zimmermann 2002: 163 rightly observes that nothing in the inscription suggests that the "oikodomoi around Epigonos" were indeed organized as an association. They seem to be just a group of workers of the same employer engaged in the same project.
