IG IX 1 ² 2, 249, A, ll. 1-5); it could be possible that before the five names (Ibid. A, ll. 1-5) there was a dedication to a specific divinity; thereafter follows a fragmentary list of συμβιωτα[ί], <i>symbiotai</i> (IG IX 1 ² 2, 249, A, ll. 6-10, B, ll. 11-15?). The fragmentary condition of side B does not allow to determine if παῖδες, <i>paides</i> , that is to say the sons of συμβιωταί, <i>symbiotai</i> , were cited too; for the interpretation of the meaning of word συμβιωτής, <i>symbiotes</i> , see CAPIv. 1108 , CAPIv. 1113 .
