XII. NOTES

i. Comments	The honorand Ariston, son of Ariston (Ariston I, to be distinguished from his homonymous son) is known as a very active member of the Bacchic <i>thiasos</i> (see CAPIv. 1186). He is called <i>euergetes tou damou</i> in I. Kallatis 40, as in some of the decrees of the <i>thiasos</i> . The fragmentary decree I. Kallatis 41 for the same Ariston I has of θοινᾶται τᾶς [- -], <i>hoi thoinatai tas [- -]</i> . It is highly probable that the <i>thoinatai</i> are those of Damater <i>Chthonia</i> .
