iii.	Members	The members are designated as oi παιρὶ εἰερέα (l. περὶ ἱερέα) Τ(ίτον) Αἴ(λιον) [M]ινί[κιον] hoi peri hire $T.$ Ai(lion) [M]ini[kion] (l. 1). There were at least four names: the hiereus, [T. Ai(lios)] Minikios Poudens (perhaps a relative of the priest), [-] Damatriou (who dedicated the table) and an anonymous γραμματεύς, grammateus.
iv.	Officials	One ἱερεύς, <i>hiereus</i> (see above). One γραμματεύς, <i>grammateus</i> (cf. l. 4: γραμματεύων, <i>grammateuon</i>).
