ii. Leadership	The text mentions Demosthenes and Pylades of the <i>koinon ergasterion</i> followed by Rufus and Glykon <i>ton proegoumenon</i> (l. 3); all are mentioned by their personal name or cognomen. The first two should be the <i>hegoumenoi</i> .
iv. Officials	The honoured priest Diophanes - mentioned only by name- must be the priest of the <i>ergasterion</i> .

iii. Worship	The group dedicates a statue as thanks-giving to the God.
Deities worshipped	Apollo <i>Gadenos</i>
iv. Honours/Other activities	The group erects a honorific statue of a priest.
