i. **Comments** Two other graffiti from Olbia ([IGDOP 83a](#) and [IGDOP 83b](#)) are dedications to Apollo *Boreas* (to be understood as Apollo victorious over the North; cf. [IGDOP 93b](#): Νικηφόρος Βορέω, *Nikephoros Boreo*). Thus, we are invited to take βορεικοί, *boreikoi*, as a theophoric name derived from Apollo's local epiclesis.
