i. **Comments** The documents record transactions with and payments made to the *grapheion*: P.Mich. II 124 recto, col. II, l. 19 records the preparation of a declaration, *χειρογράφια*, *cheirographia*, that is described as a gift/*dosis* costing or valued at four drachmas; P.Mich. II 123 recto, col. III, l. 41 records a payment for a declaration made to the inspectors (*epistatai*) for 8 drachmas; P.Mich. II 123 recto, col. XXI, l. 31 records the preparation of another declaration for the *hegoumenos*.
