Note	The only reason to suspect an association is the presence of a [νεανι]σκάρχης, [<i>neani</i>]skarches. This is, of course, a civic office but we find several cases of [νεανι]σκάρχαι, [<i>neani</i>]skarchai, in associations from the Bosporan Kingdom (CIRB 103, l. 8: see CAPInv. 1296 , VII.iii) and especially from Tanais (<i>passim</i> , mostly beside γυμνασιάρχαι, <i>gymnasiarchai</i>).
