i. Number	At least three (or four if Tetradyne is a name), but more are alluded to by the context (l. 3: ἐκ τῶν ἀπὸ τῆς συνόδου <i>ek ton apo tes synodou</i>)
ii. Gender	Men
Note	The recorded names are male names.
vi. Proper names and physical features	Diogenes (brother of Sarapion who is a member of this association); Diogenes; Theonion; Tetradyne (?)

i. Private association	Probable
Note	The terminology used suggests an association context (l.3: ἐκ τῶν ἀπὸ τῆς συνόδου, <i>ek ton apo tes synodou</i>) though the nature of the association and what exactly the letter is concerned with are unclear.
