Status	The ethnic in the name of the association, which was probably related to a village in this area, suggests that the association was one of the <i>thiasoi</i> consisting of Ptolemaic military settlers and their descendants. For these <i>thiasoi</i> , see Mitford 1961: 141-2, no. 39; Hermary 2004: 54-5; SEG 54: 1531.

iii. Worship	The association conducted animal sacrifice ( <i>to hiereon</i> , 1. 3) to Apollon in the fourth regnal year of a Ptolemaic ruler.
