ii. Leadership	l. 5 refers to ἀρχιπροστάτης <i>archiprostates</i> , whose name was Diocles (?).
iv. Officials	l. 4 contains a reference to an unnamed ἀρχισυναγωγ[ός] <i>archisynagogos</i> .
ix. Privileges	The decree suggests that the group is honoring Brasidas son of Herakleides; perhaps with special treatment at banquet and a crown (στεφάνω, <i>stephano</i> , l. 15)

ii. Gender	Men
Note	The recorded names are male names.
iii. Age	Adults
vi. Proper names and physical features	Brasidas, son of Herakleides

X. ACTIVITIES

i. Assemblies	Possibly συναγωγή <i>synagoge</i> on the basis of the supplement ἐπὶ τῆς γ[ενη]θείσης συναγωγῆς <i>epi tes genetheises synagoges</i> (ll. 2-3).
iv. Honours/Other activities	Apparently the group offered special treatment at a banquet and a crown (l. 15) for a member. It is unclear whether this was an annual event or otherwise.
