iii. Income	In <i>AAT</i> 101: 306, no. 25, the association is named as the recipient of fines that result from the violation of the tomb; the <i>kepourgoi</i> shall receive 1000 denarii. If Altertümer von Hierapolis 218 also refers to this association, they are mentioned there in the same context, but second in line after the civic treasury (500 denarii for the <i>tamion</i> , 300 for the association).
