The statue was made ( <i>ἐποίησε</i> , <i>epoiese</i> l. 11) by the prominent sculptor Χαρμόλας Ἀρτεμιδώρου Ῥόδιος, <i>Charmolas Artemidorou Rodios</i> . Charmolas is attested as the sculptor on nine occasions on Rhodes (Cl.Rho.2 190,19; Lindos II 281, 285, 293, 702; NSER 31; SEG 33:643 39:750, 41:647).
ii. Source(s) provenance	Found on the Acropolis of Lindos.
