is likely named after a founder of benefactor bearing the Greek personal name $E\dot{\upsilon}\thetaάλης$, Euthales (LGPN s.v. no.

3.)

Other: πατριωταί, patriotai - 'Fellow-

contrymen' according to LSJ. It is likely a reference to a shared communal identity among the members of the

association.
