The compound name likely suggests a founder or a benefactor of the association, (cf. Thomsen (forthcoming), Gabrielsen 1997 p. 126-7, Maiuri 1916 p. 141, Poland 1909 p. 73-6). It is also possible that the name refers to a <i>diagonia</i> , a uniquely Lidian type of association. |
