## IV. NAME AND TERMINOLOGY

ii. Name elements	Personal:	Παυσίστρα[τείο]ι, <i>Pausistra[teio]i</i> - From the Greek personal name Παυσίστρατος, <i>Pausistratos</i> (LGPN s.v. no. 1). The compound name likely suggests a founder or a benefactor of the association, (cf. Thomsen (forthcoming), Gabrielsen 1997 p. 126-7, Maiuri 1916 p. 141, Poland 1909 p. 73-6).
Note	The character of the association is greatly reminiscent of other associations described as κοινόν, <i>koinon</i> , although the descriptive term has been omitted in this case.
