τῶν σὺν Σύλλα, ton syn Syllai - A reference to the current leader of the association (lit. 'those together with Syllas'). Likely the same person as the above mentioned benefactor of the association.

Λολλείοι, Lolleion - From the Greek personal name Λολλείος, Lolleios. The compound name likely suggests a founder or a benefactor of the association, (cf. Thomsen (forthcoming), Gabrielsen 1997 p. 126-7, Maiuri 1916 p. 141, Poland 1909 p. 73-6).
