Comments	According to Bastianini and Gallazzi 1991: 45-46, who supplied the reading <i>synodos</i> (recorded in BL X 276) instead of the reading συνο(ικία) <i>synoikia</i> recorded in BL VII 27, the name Antonia after whom the association was named probably referred to the titular of an imperial estate: the members would be employed in that estate.
