XI. INTERACTION i. Local interaction It is possible to identify the honorand bearing the rare personal name Theokomos, with a Theokomos attested in an unpublished decree from a koinon thiasoton of Herakles Pankrates, mentioned by S. Tracy, Athens and Macedon, p. 51 and Athenian democracy in Transition, p. 51. If this is right, then it is only the second case on an individual member of a cult association participating in a second one.
