ii. Leadership	Perhaps the term chief- <i>eranistes</i> (ἀρχερανιστής, <i>archeranistes</i> ) in l. 5. denotes the leader of the group.
iii. Members	The members of the group are described in ll. 4-5 as οἱ μετέχοντες τῆς συνόδου, <i>hoi metechontes tes synodou</i> , and in l. 6 as ἐρανισταί, <i>eranistai</i> .

## IX. MEMBERSHIP

i. Number	At least 19 names of members survive.
ii. Gender	Men
Note	At least 19 names survive.
iii. Age	Adults
iv. Status	It is certain that three of the members are Athenian citizens (ll. 5-6, 8, 25), one is mentioned with a single name (l. 7), while the remaining sixteen are likely to be citizens.

## X. ACTIVITIES

ii. Meetings and events	τρίκλινα, <i>triklina</i> (l. 3) are mentioned: this suggests banquets.

i. Comments	The document is dated on the archonship of Nikandros.
