Note	<i>koinon</i> : IG II <sup>2</sup> 1339, ll. 5-6 <i>eranos</i> : IG II <sup>2</sup> 1339, ll. 14, 17	
Although the term κοινόν, <i>koinon</i> is wholly restored I think it is convincing since the context requires a similar term. On the other hand the term ἔρανος, <i>eranos</i> , (also part restored) is uncertain as one could easily supply <i>koinon</i> instead (ll. 14 and 17).

<b>i.b. Document(s) typology &amp; language/script</b>	Decision of the association on the payment of a modest fee by the members of the group to finance the sacrifices, with the necessary exemptions. If not, they shall be expelled. In the end there was a clause about joining the association. Written in Greek.
<b>i.c. Physical format(s)</b>	Marble stele measuring 0.27x0.22m.
<b>ii. Source(s) provenance</b>	Found in the southern slope of the Athenian Acropolis, now in the Epigraphical Museum, EM 7774.

## VII. ORGANIZATION

<b>ii. Leadership</b>	Perhaps the chief- <i>eranistes</i> (ἀρχερανιστής, <i>archeranistes</i> , l. 4) was the leading personality of the group.
<b>iv. Officials</b>	Treasurer ( <i>ταμιεύοντος</i> , <i>tamieuontos</i> , l. 2).
<b>vi. Judicial system</b>	Failure to pay the fee results in expulsion from the group, ll. 12-15: ἐὰν δὲ μὴ διδ[ῶσι   τὴν φοράν, ἔ]δοξεν μὴ μετέχειν αὐτοῖ[ν]ς   τοῦ ἑράντου ἐὰν μὴ τινι συμβῇ διὰ πέ[ν]θος ἢ διὰ ἀ]σθένειαν ἀπολειφθῆναι, <i>ean de me did[osi ten phoran, e]doksen me metechein auto[us tou eran]jou ean me tini synbei dia pe[n]thos e dia a]stheneian apoleiphthenai</i> .
<b>viii. Obligations</b>	Members were obliged to pay the fee as delineated above, ll. 6-15.
