The presence of an association in this inscription depends on the restoration of ll. 6-9: ἔδοξεν τῷ[ι κοινῷ  
τῶν δεῖνα, ἐπειδὴ Καλ[λίμαχο]ς τῶν ὁμοτίμων τοῖς συγγ[ενέσι καὶ στρατηγὸς | καὶ νο]μάρχης τοῦ  
Παθυρίτου καὶ το[ῦ ἐπιτάγματος ἵππάρχης] ἐπ' ἀνδρῶν κτλ. *edoxen to/i koinoi ton deina epeide  
Kallimacho]s ton homotimon tois syngenesi kai strategos kai no]marches tou Pathyritou kai to/u  
epitagmatois hipparches] ep'andron* etc. The dedication to Hermes and Heracles (gymnasial deities par  
excellence) in l. 3 may point towards a gymnasial environment and this dedication may have been set up  
by the κοινὼν τῶν ἀπὸ τοῦ γυμνασίου *koinon ton apo tou gymnasiou* (however the space available in the  
lacuna does not allow for such an expression) or an association of ex-ephebes. The fragmentary state of  
the inscription does not allow any safe conclusion.
