ii.	Source(s) provenance	Found near the modern village of Karlanovo, on the left bank of the Upper Strymon valley.

ii.	Leadership	The honorand, a priest of an unknown cult, was probably the leader of the association.
iii.	Members	The members are called φράτορες, <i>phratores</i> . It points to a simple, egalitarian structure.

iv. Honours/Other activities	The only source for this religious association for an unknown cult is a honorific monument for the cult's priest.

i. Private association	Probable
Note	The laconic nature of our evidence (οἱ φράτορες τῷ ἱερῖ, hoi phratores toi hieri) does not allow for certainty, but Mihailov (in IGBulg IV 2320) is probably correct in treating this inscription as evidence for a religious association.
