The word σπαργανιώτης, sparganiotes, occurs only once (H.Herm. 301), though it obviously derives from σπάργανα, spargana (swaddling-clothes) and the unattested verb σπάργω, spargo. According to Dict.Étym. s.v. σπάργω: 'un rapprochement avec la famille de σπεῖρα, σπάρτον etc. semble s'imposer'.

XII NOTES

i. Comments The term σπαργανιώτης, sparganiotes, may be interpreted as pointing to the devotees' hope of rebirth.

There are three additional inscriptions from Perinthos that contain a reference to a σπεῖρα, speira, or to a σπεῖραρχος, speirarchos: I.Perinthos 57, I.Perinthos 280 (see <u>CAPInv. 720</u> for both of them) and 313 (<u>CAPInv. 718</u>); due to inadequate information regarding their finding place, only the first two can be tentatively associated.
