Comments	The presence of an entry of expenses, indicated as the salary of someone (l. 5: Παληχίτου ὀψόνιον, <i>Palechitou opsonion</i>), seems to indicate that the account belonged to a businessman or small enterprise, who also acted as sponsor or patron – if not just as simple member – of the association.
