Honours/Other activities	<p>The association honors Alexandros, son of Alexandros, slave trader and former <i>agoranomos</i> without a stain, who had made at his expenses many donations to the city for the festivities of the Augusti.</p> <p>As <i>agoranomos</i> (and member of the elite), the honorand was surely an important benefactor of the association. Even though he was professionally a slave trader, it is still not certain that he was a member of the association.</p> <p>Cf. for possible interpretations Pleket, H.W.
