Note	<i>eranos</i> : IG XII. 7 61, l. 8  The mention of <i>eranos</i> in IG XII. 7 61, l. 8 is completely restored; there is reference to an <i>archeranos</i> in l. 9 and there are parallels with IG XII.7 58 concerning an <i>eranos</i> (= <a href="#">CAPInv. 858</a> ).

i. Comments	Note the parallel with <a href="#">CAPInv. 858</a> . It is not clear whether this is the same or a different <i>eranos</i> . There is another (unpublished) text from Arkesine which also mentions an <i>archeranos</i> (SEG 55: 965; Marangou 2005: 166, no. 449; cf. 178).
