iii. Members	The members are designated as οἱ παρὶ εἰρέα (l. περὶ ἱερέα) Τ(ίτον) Αἴ(λιον) [M]ινί[κιον] <i>hoi peri hire T. Ai(lion) [M]ini[kion]</i> (l. 1). There were at least four names: the <i>hiereus</i> , [T. Ai(lios)] Minikios Poudens (perhaps a relative of the priest), [-] Damatriou (who dedicated the table) and an anonymous γραμματεὺς, <i>grammateus</i> .
iv. Officials	One ἱερεὺς, <i>hiereus</i> (see above). One γραμματεὺς, <i>grammateus</i> (cf. l. 4: γραμματεῦον, <i>grammateuon</i>).
