iv. Status	One of the members is called [φ]ιλότε[ιμος], [<i>ph</i>] <i>ilote[imos]</i> (I.Tomis 25, l. 1). Three pontarchs (of the West Pontic community) were members (I.Tomis 25, ll. 4-6).

i. Private association	Probable
Note	The presence of the [φ]ιλότε[ιμος], [<i>ph</i>] <i>ilote[imos]</i> (as in other similar cases in Tomis) and of the pontarchs invites us to suspect a private associations.
