i. Comments	V.P. Jajlenko (2010: 613) remarks the letter H at the place where the date of CIRB 1133 is expected: therefore, he restores [νπ]η, [yp]e = 488 year of the Bosporan era = AD 191. Both documents mention a συναγωγός, <i>synagogos</i> , at the head of the association (contrary to CAPInv. 1310 , where we have a ἱερεύς, <i>hierous</i> , and a συναγωγός, <i>synagogos</i>). Therefore, we consider them two different associations.
