XIII. EVALUATION

i. Private association	Probable
Note	The use of the term <i>synodos</i> suggests that an association is involved in some way - most likely here as the recipient of the statue dedication. Without more information it is impossible to determine what type of association - whether associated with a trade, cult group, etc.
