v. Other staff	πρόξενος τῶν ἀπὸ τῆς οἰκούμενης ἱερονεικῶν (I. ἱερονικῶν), <i>proxenos ton apo tes oikoumenes hieronikon</i> (I.Didyma 272, ll. 11-13): the honorand Claudius Chionis held this office/honorary charge by the <i>hieronikai</i> .

Note	Given the character of the association, the members should be male.
iii. Age	Adults
Note	Given the character of the association, the members should be adults.
iv. Status	Claudius Chionis, who was <i>proxenos</i> of the <i>hieronikai</i> in I.Didyma 272 ll. 11-12, held various important offices and was an important local dignitary, whose family had held similar charges: prophet, <i>archiprytanis</i> , prefect at Rome, military commander at Alexandria, <i>choregos</i> , gymnasiarch, ambassador to the Emperor.

X. ACTIVITIES

ii. Meetings and events	The <i>hieronikai</i> and <i>stephanitai</i> organised athletic contexts, which included the single and double race-course and race in armour: τὸν τιθέμενον ἀγῶνα ὑπὸ τῶν ἀπὸ τῆς οἰκουμένης ἱερονικῶν καὶ στεφανῖτῶν στάδιον, δίσκον, ὁπλίτην, <i>ton tithemenon agona hypo ton apo tes oikoumenes hieronikon kai stephaniton stadion, diaulon, hopliton</i> (I.Didyma 201, ll. 5-7).
iv. Honours/Other activities	The <i>hieronikai</i> had granted the local dignitary Claudius Chionis the title of <i>proxenos</i> : I.Didyma 272 ll. 11-12.

XII. NOTES

i. Comments	Although very likely, the lack of further information does not allow any absolute certainty on whether <i>hoi apo tes oikoumenes hieronikai kai stephanitai</i> of I.Didyma 201 corresponded to <i>hoi apo tes oikoumenes hieronikai</i> of I.Didyma 272.
