ii. Name elements	Geographical:	τῶν ἐν Οἴαις, <i>ton en Oiais</i> - Specifying that the honours in the inscription were bestowed by a subsection in Oiai of the association of <i>Euthalidai patriotai</i> .
	Personal:	Εὐθαλίδαι, <i>Euthalidai</i> - The association is likely named after a founder of benefactor bearing the Greek personal name Εὐθάλης, <i>Euthales</i> (LGPn s.v. no. 3.)
	Other:	πατριωταί, <i>patriotai</i> - 'Fellow-contrymen' according to LSJ. It is likely a reference to a shared communal identity among the members of the association.
