Personal: Διωνιδείοι, Dionideioi - From the Greek

personal name Διωνίδας, Dionidas (LGPN s.v. 1). The compound name likely suggests a founder or a benefactor of the association, (cf. Thomsen (forthcoming), Gabrielsen 1997 p. 126-7, Maiuri 1916 p. 141, Poland 1909 p. 73-6). It is possible that this name element should be attributed to another association, due to the fragmentary state of the inscription.

Theophoric: Σωτηριασταί, Soteriastai - From Zeus,

specifically the epithet  $\Sigma \omega \tau \eta \rho$ , Soter (Morelli, *I Culti in Rodi* [Pisa, 1959]
