## VII. ORGANIZATION

ii. Leadership	[ἀρχισυνά]γωγος, <i>[archisyna]gogos</i> (l. 6). The same man was also high-priest of the association (ἀρχιερεύς, <i>archiereus</i> , l. 6).
iv. Officials	ἀρχιερεύς, <i>archiereus</i> (l. 6). This charge was held by the president of the association himself ([ἀρχισυνά]γωγος, <i>[archisyna]gogos</i> , l. 6).

## IX. MEMBERSHIP

ii. Gender	Men
Note	Given the fact that the members of the association belonged to the cavalry ( <i>hippeis</i> , l. 5), they were men.
iii. Age	Adults
Note	As military men, the members of the association were adults.
iv. Status	The association gathered together the cavarly-men who had their post in the Arsinoite nome (ll. 4-5).

## X. ACTIVITIES

iv. Honours/Other activities	The association of <i>hippeis</i> stationed in the Arsinoites showed their loyalty to the Royal House by dedicating the inscription on behalf of the King and Queen.

Note	The restoration [ἀρχισυνά]γωγος, <i>[archisyna]gogos</i> in l. 6 seems certain and would leave no doubts about this being a private association.
