The reasons for considering the group as an association are the term servants (θεράποντες, *therapontes*, I. 3) and the identity of the dedicators as κομωδοὶ περιοδονεῖκαι, I. περιοδονίκαι, *komodoi periodonikai*, II. 13-5. However, none of the above is sufficient to base an argument about the existence of a group.
