ii. Reference context	<p>The text is partly preserved. The preserved lines mention arrangements for the payments of debts. Despite the fragmentary state of preservation, the text seems to constitute a decree/ list of regulations passed probably by civic authorities, something that can be further corroborated by the findspot of the inscription, i.e. in the prytaneion.</p> <p>The term <i>thiasotika</i> is juxtaposed to the term <i>choritika</i> (l. 5: ἢ θιασωτικά ἢ χωριτικά). It may refer to plots of land (χωρία?) of private associations.</p>
