## XIII. EVALUATION

<b>i. Private association</b>	Probable
<b>Note</b>	The only reason to suspect an association is the presence of a [νεανι]σκάρχης, [ <i>neani</i> ]skarches. This is, of course, a civic office but we find several cases of [νεανι]σκάρχαι, [ <i>neani</i> ]skarchai, in associations from the Bosporan Kingdom (CIRB 103, l. 8: see <a href="#">CAPInv. 1296</a> , VII.iii) and especially from Tanais ( <i>passim</i> , mostly beside γυμνασιάρχαι, <i>gymnasiarchai</i> ).
