Note	The identification of a group of imperial tenant farmers as a private association is perhaps a little problematic given their employment; nevertheless, if we are to assume that the <i>apolsimoi</i> of P.Mich. V 244 ( <a href="#">CAPInv. 1409</a> ) are, in fact, a private association, then it seems likely that this group is too.
