ii. Name elements	Personal:	Ἀγητοριδαί, <i>Hagetoridai</i> - From the Greek personal name Ἀγήτωρ, <i>Hageter</i> (LGPN s.v. no. 18). The compound name likely suggests a founder or a benefactor of the association, (cf. Thomsen (forthcoming), Gabrielsen 1997 p. 126-7, Maiuri 1916 p. 141, Poland 1909 p. 73-6). It is also possible that the name refers to a <i>diagonia</i> , a uniquely Lindian type of association.
